It's that time of year...time to submit requests for donations from Zion's Touching Tomorrow Endowment Fund!

What is the purpose of the "Touching Tomorrow" Endowment fund?

The Endowment Fund distributes money, in the form of grants, for mission and outreach beyond the normal church budget and usually, beyond the church walls. The aim of such grants is to "Touch Tomorrow," allowing for present and future ministry.

Who oversees the Touching Tomorrow Fund?

A Touching Tomorrow Committee oversees the Fund. This committee meets annually to decide expenditures based on the financial performance of the account and the specific requests. These purchases are not approved by council, but council approves the members of the committee. The committee currently consists of Jim Cascarino, Jim Gill (Chair), Terry Ludwig, Michelle Bucks, and Christine Techky. If you'd like to help, please see Jim Gill or Pastor Caitlin.

Where does the money come from in the Touching Tomorrow Fund?

The original money came from a large bequest to the church. Currently the fund has roughly \$4**5**0,000 in principal investments, which includes the original gift, but also later gifts and interest added to principal. Each year grants come from the interest and dividends on the account. These have varied over time. The hope is that in the future, more people will consider giving money, either in honor of loved ones, or as part of their estate planning, to the Touching Tomorrow Fund.

How can I contribute to the Touching Tomorrow Fund?

Gifts of any size are greatly appreciated, and you may benefit from significant tax advantages. By using a combination of certain financial and insurance products, you can even leave a bigger inheritance to your loved ones while preserving your desired gift to the fund. For more information on this strategy, you may consult your estate attorney or talk with Jim Gill, Zion's representative from Thrivent Financial.

What kind of things has the Touching Tomorrow Fund supported?

Between 2006 and 2023, the Fund distributed over \$225,000 to various projects, including:

- Donation's to Zion's member towards studies at United Lutheran Seminary
- Cover cost for new washing machine and clothes dryer for the NL Clothing Closet
- Funding of the Capital Campaign to pay down the loan for Zion's building reovations
- Tuition for three students for three years at Konde Diocese bible college in Tanzania
- Continued support for Zion's Preschool with scholarships for preschool families in need
- Financial support for Pastor Ted's caner recovery fund
- Quilting supplies for Zion's Quilters to support LWR and CWS outreach
- Financial assistance with housing for youth aging out of the foster system

What kind of money is available for grants this year?

Because the endowment fund is invested conservatively, fluctuations in the returns mean that each year's donation amount will vary. In 2023, we were able to distribute **over \$20,000 and** in 2024 we are blessed to be able to distribute over \$40,000!

How can you make a request for a project?

Fill out the front of this paper by *Dec 1, 2024*, and return to Zion's by email (zions@comcast.net), snail mail (Zion's Evangelical Lutheran Church, PO Box 658, Jonestown, PA 17038) or by placing it in the "Endowment" mailbox at church, located outside the secretary's office.

The most successful applications tend to benefit educational ministries (scholarships, youth group, leadership training), local ministries (innovative congregational ministries, seed money, or emergency appeals), extended ministries (national, international, disaster-related), and charities with specific needs.
